The National Association of Letter Carriers collected nearly 16,000 pounds of non-perishable food for those served by the Food Bank during the Annual Stamp Out Hunger Food Drive.

Texarkana International Rotary Club has volunteered with the food bank for several years, helping to pack food boxes for families in the community.



Buffalo Soldiers and Troopers Motorcycle Club volunteered at the food bank helping to sort through mixed food that will be packed and distributed throughout the ten county serving area.
